
torquered. Then push helix over the studs and use the M6 nylock nuts to fasten the helix in place. **Lightly tighten** the helix so it sits flat on the machined surfaces where the plastic buttons use to be. You will notice a slight interference fit is created between the movable sheave and helix, this will lock the helix in place. Torque helix nylock nuts to 36 in-lbs of torque. See figure #3.





## Frequently Asked Questions

How do the multi-radius helixes compare to constant radius helixes? A good reference is 12 degree progressive angle. Our 38 straight cut multiradius helix acts like a Yamaha 46/34 on the up shift, but a straight 38 on the backshift.

What secondary springs fould I use? The decreasing radius touch point allows for more belt squeezing a the full shift our point. This means softer springs can be used. Stock Yamaha Green for the Viper and Silver for the SRX are recommended.

Can I use the HC-X<sup>TM</sup> with conventional clutch weights, or do I have to use Heel Clicker<sup>TM</sup> weights? For the best performance a combination of Heel Clicker<sup>TM</sup> and HC-X<sup>TM</sup> is the best, but the HC-X<sup>TM</sup> is a stand alone product and can be used with a sconventional weights. A 42 or 46 degree helix is recommended if stock weights are used.

Set up information for Heel Clicker<sup>TM</sup> Clutch Weights w/ HC-X<sup>TM</sup>:

**700 SRX**: 40-10Y(4.2 shoulder,6.3 center,6.3 tip), Red primary spring, HC-X<sup>TM</sup> 42/34 degree, Green secondary spring (stock) at 6-3 twist

700 Viper: 40-10Y(1.3 shoulder.5.3center 4.3tip), Gray primary spring, HC-X 42/34 degree, Silver secondary spring 6-2 twist.

**RX-1:** 92-11Y(3.2 shoulder, 0.0 center, 5.3 tip), White primary spring HC-X 42-34 degree, Pink secondary spring (stock) at 3-3 twist.

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
